Program:

Our guest speaker was none other than our meeting host, Costa Stylianou, owner of Costa s Grill and manger of Lincoln Pancake House.

Costa was born in a small town in Cyprus and immigrated to the United States when he was 21 years of age. He was single, at the time, and migrated to Chicago where he started his first restaurant at age 24. He attended University of Illinois where he met his wife, who works at Hancock Hospital. He has 2 sons; one is attending Indiana University on a scholarship and his other son is an electrician s apprentice.

Costa has been in the restaurant business for 30 years; he did spend a brief period bringing Greek musical entertainers to the USA, where they performed at major venues in New York, Chicago, and Las Vegas. Costa learned how to cook from his mother and by reading books. He gets great joy introducing new ideas and food to his local community. His products come from places like Tyner Pond Farm in Greenfield and Boar s Head in New Castle.

He came to Greenfield several years ago when he partnered with an old friend, who purchased several properties in the Indianapolis are, including Greenfield. They invested quite a bit of money to restore the building housing Lincoln Square Pancake House, which needed major renovation. Costa owns and is partners in 4 restaurants in Indianapolis, Fortville, and Greenfield. He was planning to open a restaurant in New Palestine but held off due to the Corona Virus.

Costa shared with the club just how much joy he derives from interacting with customers. He emphasized his appreciation to the Rotary Club for choosing his restaurant to host our meetings. He is most grateful for the support the community has given him during this difficult and challenging pandemic.
