Message from Our President

1) The Rotary Board met today and determined it would be in the best interest of our membership for the Club to return to virtual meetings. This is effective immediately and will continue through the end of the year (except for December 17 - more on that in a minute). As a result, we will **not** be meeting in-person at Costa's Grill anymore in 2020. The login information for tomorrow's meeting is:

2) I spoke with Costa about an hour ago and explained the Club's situation. He completely understands. Given the short notice, I asked if the Club could offset any costs (i.e., food costs, etc.) he may have incurred prepping for our meeting tomorrow. In true Costa fashion, he said it is no problem, don't worry about it, it is his pleasure to help us. The next time you are looking for a dinner option or some take-out, please consider Costa's Grill. He has been a great supporter, and I know he would appreciate it.

3) Today, the Board further considered issues our members have had with meeting attendance since July 1, 2020 (whether it be concerns with the ability to join meetings in-person or virtually) as well as the attendance requirements going forward through the end calendar year 2020. In the end, the Board decided to waive any attendance requirements for members through December 31, 2020. Further, an exception will be given to any member whose attendance percentage may have fallen below the requisite number up to this point. Attendance will still be taken at meetings, however, to count toward a year-end perfect attendance award.

4) At the present time, the Club is still planning on holding our annual 30-second Auction at Stillinger Family Funeral Home on Thursday, December 17, 2020, beginning at noon. This is our regular meeting time. Masks will be required and social distancing will be encouraged. David Stillinger has indicated we should have ample space, but whether or not we will have food at the meeting is still being evaluated. Donated auction items can be dropped off at the home of Barbara Anders - 1105 Morningside Court in the Cricket Reel Subdivision. Barbara is also trying to lock down a few drop-off locations for donations, here in town.

5) I was planning on beginning the inductions of our soon to be Rotarians - Adam Jurs, Debra Smith, David Elser and Sherry Haines - starting tomorrow. My preference is, as long as there may be another way, the inductions not take place virtually. So, I am hopeful the four can be inducted in-person on December 17 as well.

6) During the month of November, the District will be matching Paul Harris Points for any contributions made to the General Fund. The minimum contribution to the General Fund is \$25, and contributions of \$100 up to \$5,000 are required for the District Match.

7) Lastly, we already planned to not have a regular weekly meeting on November 26 (Thanksgiving) and December 24 (Christmas Eve). Today, the Board voted to also not have a meeting on December 31 (New Year's Eve).
