RAY KRAMP, our District Governor, spoke to us today



about his goals for District 6560. There are approximately 1800 members in the forty-four Rotary clubs that make up the district. RAY has been pleased to see how the clubs have hit the ground running with fund raisers and projects after the long period of inactivity due to

Covid-19. SHEKHAR MEHTA is our new Rotary International President and he has encouraged District Governors to "Think Big! Do Big!" There are currently 1.2 million Rotarians around the world and the goal is to have 1.3 million by July, 2022. One suggestion is to have a Rotary Day of Service and to invite others from outside of the club to participate and get to know members and Rotary values. Our district has a task force for diversity, equity and inclusion that will work towards building a more diverse membership. Another focus is peace and conflict resolution. In 2022 there will be some conflict resolution training opportunities offered. President SHEKHAR also would like to see projects that empower girls with sixty-two million girls currently either not in school or struggling to stay in school. In the past year, members from our district have donated \$178,000 to The Rotary Foundation. DG KRAMP would like to see a total of \$300,000 given this year. Although the Rotary Youth Exchange and the Rotary Youth Leadership Awards programs were canceled for the past two years, they will resume in 2022.
