DICK RAHDERT spoke to us about The Rotary Foundation and ways of donating and the various levels of recognition. We have six members who are part of the Paul Harris Society for pledging \$1,000 per year to TRF. They are DAVE FILMER, BILL HATFIELD, CHRISTA KECK, TIM LUZADER, DICK RAHDERT, and CHIP RUTLEDGE. Our newest Major Donor is TIM LUZADER. Only 28% of our members give to TRF, but the goal is for Every Rotarian to give Every Year. Money donated to TRF comes back to our District and then back to us in the form of matching grants. Money donated to the Permanent Fund is invested to provide earnings for the future. Thanks to all who include TRF in their charitable giving.

GAIL BRICKLER chair of the Major Project Committee presented the four projects selected for consideration as recipients of the 2021 Ice Cream Crawl profits. The four projects are:

ADA Fishing Nodes in Columbian Park. These platforms will allow those in wheelchairs to fish in the lagoon.



Imagination Library. This program provides free books for children ages 0-5 in Tippecanoe County. We supported this with funds from the Ice Cream Crawl in 2019 and 2020.



It's My Closet. This program provides free clothing and school uniforms to students in Lafayette School Corporation and their families.



LUM Emergency Shelter. This program provides shelter for as many as forty-four homeless adults each night.
