The Rotary International Convention was held June 1-5 in Hamburg, Germany. Both CHRISTINE MILLS and BOB STOLZ attended and came back inspired and impressed by the scope of Rotary in the world and the way Rotarians are addressing serious issues. There were a total of 25,000 in attendance from more than 170 countries. Jim Mills also attended with CHRISTINE and he shared some of his experiences with us today since CHRISTINE couldn't be with us. It is impressive that Nigeria is nearly polio-free and there are only two countries experiencing new cases of the disease, Afghanistan and Pakistan. The number of Rotaractors is growing around the world and a decision has been made by RI that Rotaractors are now officially



Rotarians. BOB enjoyed meeting up with a German exchange student his family hosted in 1997-1998 and meeting members of the Lafayette Rotary Club - from France! A decision has been made that Rotary will partner with Toastmaster, an organization with 370,000 members. One goal spoken about is to have women make up at least one-third of the leadership of Rotary International by the year 2023.
