## PROGRAM:

Wes Tillett is the new director of Lafayette Urban



Ministry. LUM is sponsored by 47 churches in the Lafayette area and provides 20 programs in order to "touch the future by helping children and families today." The programs fall into five categories: 1) Assistance: providing emergency financial needs; acquiring valid IDs; legal immigration

and filing taxes. 2) Children: 5<sup>th</sup> quarter summer learning program; after school program; LUM camp; and Jubilee Christmas. 3) Food: weekly protein food pantry; and annual Community Thanksgiving celebration. 4) Shelter: emergency shelter; winter warming station; and Isaiah 32 program helping families find affordable, quality housing. 5) Events and Advocacy: Hunger Hike; LUM Follies; Port of Hope; Turkey Trot; Dream Team; Seeds of Vision; and Social Justice. Wes focused his talk on LUM camp, which will take place July 27 through 31. This camp is

held at Hanging Rock Christian Camp in Warren County and has been held since the 1960's. The theme this year will be "Join the Green Side" to promote basic ecology and nature preservation. The cost for each camper is approximately \$350, but families are only charged \$5 for each child. The camp is open to families that have used LUM services, but this year will involve only 60 children so that social distancing measures will be possible. It is obvious that LUM provides services that are beneficial to many individuals and to our community as a whole.

There were 20 members present plus 1 guest. On Zoom there were 24 members plus 1 guest.
