He also shared some of the stories of his staff being kept on the payroll when his store was shut down for its recent renovation. They continued to be paid as long as they logged volunteer hours in our community. Chris further discussed the normal challenges of being in the food service business and the added challenges due to COVID-19, including staffing and supply chain.
