Plainfield Youth Assistance Program



Mark Todisco, Town of Plainfield Clerk/Treasurer, and our own Diane Burks gave a presentation on the Plainfield Youth Assistance Program (PYAP). Both Diana and Mark are on the PYAP board. The Plainfield Youth Assistance Program serves as a voluntary early intervention and prevention advocacy process for youth, ages 3-17, and families who have experienced challenging life circumstances. PYAP is a program of volunteers and collaborative agencies that utilizes a holistic process to bring together local resources and provide support, enrichment, and unique opportunities for youth and their parents & caregivers.

Its vision is to reduce the incidence of delinquency, abuse, and neglect through community involvement and ensure that all Plainfield youth and families have the necessary support and resources they need for productive development.

PYAP is a pilot program within our county and state, and if all goes well we can expect that similar programs will be implemented county and statewide. Our club has made an investment in this program via a \$2000 grant with a matching \$2000 from our Rotary District Grant program.
