Program Update - Oct. 28th
Senator Mike Young
(R - 35th District)



State Senator Mike Young visited our club last week to speak about criminal justice sentencing reform. Mike represents Indiana's 35th Senate District, which includes Plainfield south of Township Line Road as well as Decatur Township and most of Speedway. He is the current Chair of our State Senate's Corrections and Criminal Law Committee.

Mike talked about the state legislatures efforts beginning seven or eight years ago to reform our state Criminal Code—a topic very relevant to our members in the corrections field and to Plainfield in general because of the two prison facilities that have been here for many years. These efforts were not easy and continue to be ongoing, but culminated a few years ago in major changes to the code that put much more emphasis on incarcerating those who had been convicted of major crimes that did harm to other people. Conversely, it de-emphasized prison time for lesser crimes.
