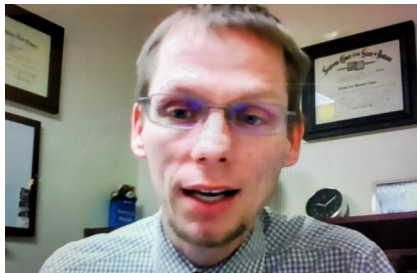

**Program Update - Jan. 27th
Travis Crane, Deputy Hendricks
County Prosecutor**



At the invitation of member Candace Balzano, Travis Crane, Hendricks County's primary Deputy Prosecutor for Juvenile offenses, visited our club on Jan. 27th. He did not provide statistics about crime or prosecutions in our county. He told an amazing and inspiring story about himself...

Travis is the third of four brothers who grew up in an abusive, drug-addicted home. He shared that his mother considered aborting him, but the person who was going to pay for the abortion backed out. His mother read and wrote at a 3rd grade level and there was no emphasis on education in his home. Travis only attended school for about 40 days (out of 180) as a freshman, but ultimately he was the first person in his family to graduate from high school. He met a youth minister, Doug Crane, when he was nine. Doug and his family became powerful influences in Travis' life, and eventually, when Travis was 22, Doug adopted him (yes, an adult can be adopted...). He went on to college, graduating from IUPUI third in his class, then went on to law school at Valparaiso U., graduating in 2015. When he graduated from college, his adoptive family was there to celebrate his accomplishments, but not his biological family. He has worked for our Prosecutor's office since 2016. He married a young lady he met while in law school and they are now the proud parents of a baby girl.

What an inspirational story!
