Program Update - June 30th Sandy Bennett

Madina Village School Board Member



Our friend, and fellow Rotarian Joe Bennett's wife, Sandy Bennett visited our club last week to provide an update on the Madina Village School in Sierra Leone. The school is located in the small village of Madina and has been one of Plainfield Rotary's charitable beneficiaries over the last few years. Sandy will be traveling to Madina in September, for the second time, to use her training and experience as an elementary school teacher to assist local teachers in developing their own skills. MVS is a primary school, educating students from Kindergarten through 5th Grade. Its

students consistently score very well on the entrance exams to move into the middle schools in Sierra Leone. MVS is loosely affiliated with the United Methodist Church and is considered a private school. It receives no financial assistance from the Sierra Leone government. Its leadership has plans to eventually expand into the middle school grades, but first they have turned their focus to building a local hospital, as there are no local medical facilities. The hospital's main structure and much of its electrical and plumbing are nearing completion. The hospital's next priority is to create an adequate clean water supply. It needs to drill a well, construct a water tower & storage tank, install plumbing for the water system, and install a solar power system to run the system. Madina Village requires a total of approx. \$28,000 to complete the water supply system.



Michael Reynolds, along with his parents, also visited our club last week to accept his John W. Himmelheber Memorial Scholarship. Michael will be attending Purdue University, planning to major in nursing. We congratulate him and wish him well in his studies at Purdue and in all of his future endeavors!
