Program Update - July 21st

Jordan Brouillard

**General Manager, Plainfield Recreation
& Aquatic Center**



Jordan Brouillard visited our club last week to provide an update on what is happening in the world of Plainfield Parks & Recreation. Jordan's specific responsibility is managing the Richard A. Carlucci Recreation and Aquatic Center, a real gem of a facility not only for the Town of Plainfield but for the entire county. He began his career with the Rec Center as a lifeguard in high school, and has now been working for our town for more than half of his life.

Jordan shared that Plainfield has approximately 700 acres of parks, and 20 miles of trails. Fees cover about 80% of the total budget of the Parks Department, defraying much of the department's burden on the taxpayer. Further, the town has recently taken over the management of Sodalis Park. The biggest upcoming project is revising the master plan for Franklin Park. Plainfield is currently seeking public input regarding this project, which already includes the relocation of the park's Pee-Wee baseball fields. The relocation of these fields will provide more space for other recreational activities.
