Program Update - August 4th **Andrew Klinger** **Town Manager, Plainfield**



Last week fellow Rotarian Andrew Klinger, Town Manager of Plainfield, provided the club an update on what is going on in our town. He and town leaders are busy, as always. One of the many topics Andrew touched upon was the town's takeover of the previously county-run Sodalis Park, and plans to potentially expand that park and perhaps even build some lodging on the site, making it similar to some of Indiana's smaller state parks. He also discussed the recently opened MADE@Plainfield facility adjacent to Plainfield High School. MADE@Plainfield is an exciting new partnership with higher education and workforce training institutions and resources, including Ivy Tech Community College, Vincennes University, Indiana Department of Homeland Security/Indiana Fire & Public Safety Academy, WorkOne, Hendricks College Network, the Town of Plainfield, and Plainfield Community School Corporation. The 100,000 sq. ft. building will provide training and degree programs to support job and career success for adults of all ages. Courses will include industrial maintenance, general education, robotics, supply chain, CDL training, medical assisting, information technology, accounting, logistics, business, public safety training, and some high school/college dual credit courses. Andrew also shared the plans regarding the new Town Hall and performing arts center, and the fact that the entire complex is not expected to be completely finished until 2023.
