Program Update - August 11th Rotary Education Rotary Foundation



President Brian plans on using our club's traditional Club Assembly time in a new way this year—to serve as a vehicle to educate and reacquaint fellow Rotarians on various aspects of Rotary International.

This month Brian provided a briefing on Rotary Grants, both District and Global. Our club has been active in recent years with District Grants, using them to match our own contributions to efforts such as the Imagination Lab, Susie's Place, and the Plainfield Youth Assistance Program. Funding for these grants is in part based upon contributions from Plainfield Rotary club members to the Rotary Foundation. The Foundation has various programs to promote giving. The most well-known of those is the Paul Harris Fellow program, which honors those who have given more than \$1,000 over time to the Foundation. Below, Brian presents Paul Harris Fellow recognition pins to both John and Jan Baer. These pins each have 3 sapphires—emblematic of having achieved Paul Harris Fellow status four times.
