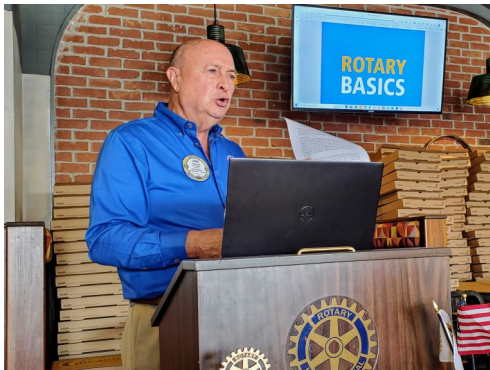

Program Update - Oct 13th

Your club's Secretary, John Baer, provided a Rotary orientation & refresher last week. He covered Rotary Basics, including the fact that Rotary currently has more than 1.2 million members in over 35,000 clubs all over the world (220+ countries). The first Rotary club was founded in Chicago, and had its initial meeting on February 23, 1905. The club was started by attorney Paul Harris, who was joined by Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey. The club got its name because early meetings rotated among the offices of the members.

In addition to our 35,000 clubs, Rotary also offers expanded service opportunities via Interact clubs for ages 12-18, and Rotaract clubs for young adults. There are more than 20,300 Interact clubs in 159 countries.

Solving real problems takes real commitment and vision. Each year, Rotary members invest hundreds of millions of dollars and countless volunteer hours to promote health, peace and prosperity in their local communities and across the globe. For more than 30 years, Rotary has been the driving force in the effort to end polio worldwide. Alongside the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, Rotary has achieved a 99.9% reduction in polio cases, with less than 200 cases of wild polio reported in 2019 compared with 350,000 a year in the late 1980s. Rotarians have contributed \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect more than 3 billion children in 122 countries from this paralyzing disease.
