Veterans Day 2021



Tomorrow we celebrate Veterans Day, originally known as Armistice Day to commemorate the signing of the armistice ending hostilities of "The Great War" on the 11th hour of the 11th day of the 11th month in 1918. In November 1919 President Woodrow Wilson proclaimed November 11th as the first Armistice Day with the following words: "To us in America, the reflections of Armistice Day will be filled with solemn pride in the heroism of those ... in the country's service and with gratitude for the victory ..." In 1926, Congress passed a further resolution inviting the people of the U.S. to observe this day in schools and churches, or other suitable places, with appropriate ceremonies of friendly relations with all other peoples.

In 1954, after World War II and the Korean Conflict, President Dwight Eisenhower signed legislation changing the name of this day to Veterans Day, and on November 11, 1954 this date became one to honor American veterans of all wars. Veterans Day and Independence Day remain the only two "National" holidays still celebrated on a specific date.

We are forever grateful for all American veterans, especially those who have continued their service through Rotary nationwide and here in our own club.
