### Monday's Program



Rex McKinney, CEO of Decatur County Memorial Hospital, addressed his fellow Rotarians regarding COVID and the vaccine. DCMH was one of the first 50 hospitals in Indiana selected to administer the vaccine. 2200 vaccines are available and 280 people have been given their first of two doses. The state has strict mandates regarding the vaccination process.

Rex is expecting a surge in COVID cases over the next few days from holiday gatherings. DCMH is and has been well prepared to deal with COVID patients. PPE supplies have never been in short supply. There are currently 6 positive COVID patients in the hospital and 8 staff members out. Over the course of the pandemic 150 of the 500 employees have been unable to work due to being COVID positive or in quarantine.

Rex also spoke about future developments for DCMH including new staff doctors, property purchases for expansion and a collaboration with the YMCA for a wellness pavilion onsite at the Y. We appreciate Rex taking time out of his busy schedule to bring us up to date on these important matters.
