Bread of Life is Decatur County's only soup kitchen. With the help of 50 to 70 volunteers; food donations and rescues from local groceries, restaurants, and local individuals; and monetary donations from the community and organizations such as Decatur County Community Foundation and the United Fund, Bread of Life supplies free meals to people in need.

Currently located at 700 E. Randall St. in Greensburg, Bread of Life will soon be moving into their new, larger facility.
