We were pleased to have Mayor Joshua Marsh join our Zoom meeting Monday. He presented his State of the City video in which he shared the accomplishments the city made in 2020 despite the pandemic. Major projects such as the new water plant, paving of streets, new sidewalks and the airport expansion continued.

Marsh is also looking forward to developments in 2021 and beyond. These include renovation of City Hall, continued construction of Pirate Park (with the hopes it will eventually attract national soccer tournaments with 40 fields) and the multi-phase Park Road project adding a biking and walking path to the fairgrounds and city park. This is at least a 10-year project. While 2020 was a challenging year for the new mayor he feels we fared better than most communities and are on a path to more growth and success.
