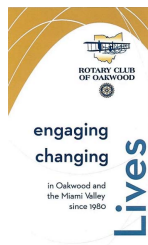

Speaker - Robert Signom III

Our speaker at the June 4, 2021 club meeting was Robert Signom III, curator of the Citizens Motorcar Company, America's Packard Museum in Dayton, Ohio. His presentation was very informative and interesting. The Packard Museum was originally founded in 1992 by Mr. Signom's father Robert E. Signom II in a former Packard Automobile dealership building located at 420 Ludlow Street, Dayton, Ohio built in 1917. There are currently 75 vehicles on display at the museum. Car Collector magazine named the museum one of the "top ten" museums in the United States and Society of Automotive Historians conferred the prestigious James J. Bradley Award to the museum for its "exemplary efforts" in preserving motorcar vehicle resource materials. The museum is open to the public on designated hours for a nominal fee.
