School and City Issues are the one exception and again their presentation is to be purely on the facts of the issue and not for or against in any way.

A member is always free to make an announcement during happy bucks if they choose as this comes from the individual. But again these should be purely fact based or an announcement of the details of an event (where, when, how to contact, etc.), and not be a comment leaning to one side or another in the political arena.
