Be gender neutral since you don t know the gender of the recipient. Specific references to religion are not permitted since there is no way we would know the religious beliefs of any particular military member and because Blue Star Mothers is a VSO chartered by Congress - e.g. inclusion of long prayers, citing of religious literature such as Bible verses, etc. A simple �you are in my thoughts �, �you are in my prayers •, or �bless you are okay.

If children are sending pictures or notes, please ask them to include their first name only and their age - do not include last name or address
