How we strive for safety with in-person Rotary meetings

- Limit in-person attendance to 35 per meeting
- Limit a maximum of 4 people per dining table/ 2 per bar-top table
- Masks required except when eating
- Full meal service no self-serve items

- Request members monitor their temperatures and stay home if symptoms arise
- Request members abstain from in-person meetings if a member of their household tests positive or is symptomatic

If children are sending pictures or notes, please ask them to include their first name only and their age - do not include last name or address
