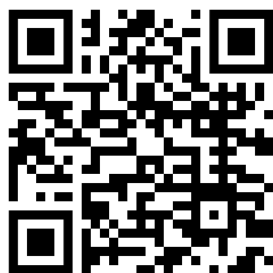
WARM Community Prayer Event May 6
