National Veterans Museum - Rotary Tour November 7

Join Sunrise Rotarians at the National Veterans Memorial and Museum Sunday, November 7 Our Museum Group Tours will begin at 3:00 pm and every 10 minutes thereafter, with the last tour starting at 3:50 pm. A maximum of 15 people will be permitted in each tour group. The tours last approximately 45 minutes Guests are encouraged to visit all three levels of the NVM and the outdoor gardens before and/or after your guided tour. Currently, a special limited engagement on PTSD is located on the lower level.

Parking is located in the lot directly west of the National Veterans Memorial and Museum (enter from Broad Street at traffic light). Bring your parking ticket with you into NVM and your ticket will be validated at the Welcome Desk for a discount rate of \$5 for up to 3 hours. Veterans, Active-Duty Military and Gold Star Families receive complimentary parking validation stickers. Upon exit, payment is made via credit card only with your validated parking ticket. You should expect to arrive at least 15 minutes before your tour starts and make your way to the entrance. Standard COVID protocol as required by Columbus includes wearing masks, social distancing, etc.

The cost for the tour of the National Veterans Memorial and Museum is \$12 per person. As our Club needs to pay for all admissions in advance, your sign-up commits you to paying the \$12 per person even if you are not able to attend. NOTE: Veterans, Active Military, Gold Star Families and members of the NVM are free of charge • PLEASE note this on your sign-up genius reservation. It also just so happened around this time that Westerville South High School was due for a renovation & expansion and the Westerville Education Foundation was hosting focus groups between student and community leaders to identify what the students wanted most to facilitate a positive learning environment. Upon listening to the students, one of the things they wanted most was a safe space in the schools. Serendipity! The idea for a

Rotary Peace Garden came into being and with the collaboration of John Kellog, Jeff LaRose and was the waterfall graphic that

Scott Dorne with WCS, and Bob Gibson from Triad Architects our contributions were accepted. The first project in Mark's year was the waterfall graphic that you can see on the windows in the background of these pictures. My year's grant was the trellis we stained last Friday. The subsequent two years(?) will include the pavers to finish the space and branding it the Rotary Peace Garden.

It is our hope that this multi-year, grant funded project fulfills on the idea of a safe space and communicates to South's students that there is a community ready to support their need for Peace. Thank you to Mark, Bob and John for their willingness to join projects over their Presidential years to see this project through. And thank you to all of the Sunrise Members who contribute to the RI and WSR Foundations; your donations make projects like this possible."
