- Golfers are asked to be in and stay in their carts by 8:15am for Opening Remarks/Invocation/Pledge
- Golfers are asked to wear masks and practice social distancing wherever groups start to form (i.e. - Putting Green) or whenever entering a building (i.e. - clubhouse or building housing lunch). This is required.
- A "To Go" Buffet Lunch will be available when making the turn. Golfers will be given food in a 'to go' container and are asked to stop no more than 5 minutes (Masks required)
- Prize winners will be posted where the buffet lunch is being served. Please check your raffle tickets and pick up your prize at the designated location at that time or at the end of play. Please practice social distancing guidelines while doing so.

But again these should be purely fact based or an announcement of the details of an event (where, when, how to contact, etc.), and not be a comment leaning to one side or another in the political arena.

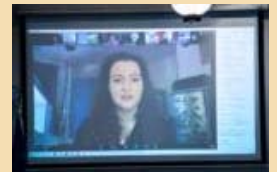
