How we strive for safety with in-person Rotary meetings

- Limit in-person attendance to 35 per meeting
- Limit a maximum of 4 people per dining table/ 2 per bar-top table
- Masks required except when eating
- Full meal service - no self-serve items
- Require safe distancing when standing/interacting
- Request members monitor their temperatures and stay home if symptoms arise
- Request members abstain from in-person meetings if a member of their household tests positive or is symptomatic
- Request members confidentially report positive test results to President Tom so contact tracing can be performed
- Sunrise Rotary will continue to address COVID-19 concerns with the sensitivity and transparency necessary to preserve the safety of all involved

Be gender neutral since you don't know the gender of the recipient.

Specific references to religion are not permitted since there is no way we would know the religious beliefs of any particular military member and because Blue Star Mothers is a VSO chartered by Congress - e.g. inclusion of long prayers, citing of religious literature such as Bible verses, etc. A simple ♦you are in my thoughts♦, ♦you are in my prayers♦, or ♦bless you♦ are okay.

If children are sending pictures or notes, please ask them to include their first name only and their age - do not include last name or address.

Do not send anything partisan or political.
