Last Chance - National Veterans Museum Tour Nov 7

Join Sunrise Rotarians at the National Veterans Memorial and Museum Sunday, November 7.

Our Museum Group Tours will begin at 3:00 pm and every 10 minutes thereafter, with the last tour starting at 3:50 pm. A maximum of 15 people will be permitted in each tour group. The tours last approximately 45 minutes. Guests are encouraged to visit all three levels of the NVM and the outdoor gardens before and/or after your guided tour. Currently, a special limited engagement on PTSD is located on the lower level.

Parking is located in the lot directly west of the National Veterans Memorial and Museum (enter from Broad Street at traffic light). Bring your parking ticket with you into NVM and your ticket will be validated at the Welcome Desk for a discount rate of \$5 for up to 3 hours. Veterans, Active-Duty Military and Gold Star Families receive complimentary parking validation stickers. Upon exit, payment is made via credit card only with your validated parking ticket. You should expect to arrive at least 15 minutes before your tour starts and make your way to the entrance. Standard COVID protocol as required by Columbus includes wearing masks, social distancing, etc.

The cost for the tour of the National Veterans Memorial and Museum is \$12 per person. As our Club needs to pay for all admissions in advance, your sign-up commits you to paying the \$12 per person even if you are not able to attend. NOTE: Veterans, Active Military, Gold Star Families and members of the NVM are free of charge ♦ PLEASE note this on your sign-up genius reservation. Locally, the Ellis E. Woodrow Memorial Post 7883, Veterans of Foreign Wars is proud to support that effort, laying wreaths at Otterbein Cemetery in Westerville. Our wreath laying ceremony will honor the 525 Veterans that call Otterbein Cemetery their final resting place, including those that fought in every conflict from the War of 1812 through the War on Terror. Following the ceremony, those in attendance will be invited to participate by placing wreaths on the grave site of a Veteran.
