- AG Jo Sexton presented 125 Club pins to Barb Gibbs, Tom Heins, Del Dunlap, and Caribeth Legats.



- Zanesville Daybreak Rotary Foundation Chairman Doug Waltman conducted the annual meeting of the Foundation. The Foundation is a separate 501(c)(3) organization able to accept tax deductible contributions with a separate Board of Directors. All members of the Zanesville Daybreak Rotary are members of the organization and entitled to vote. Current directors are Doug Waltman, President, Ron David, Gary Hamilton, Jeff Moore, John Pattison, and Pete Hamilton. President elect Dylan Perry, Past President Ed Mulholland, and Treasurer Brad Lynch were also members for 2020-2021.



Pete Hamilton and John Pattison completed their three (3) year term and were subsequently

reelected by the membership for an additional three (3) years, starting July 1, 2021.

Doug then presented a check to Corey for \$7,460.00 to fund the following projects:

- \$2,500.00 to Habitat for Humanity, pledge of \$7,500.0 over 3 years
- \$2,100.00 to the Carr Center Safety Town
- \$2,160 to the summer food program at West Muskingum
- \$700 to Christ's Table for their reopening onsite dining

The funding this year was about half of what the Foundation has been able to do in recent years because we were unable to hold the Foundation Auction this past year. So plan to attend the Auction on September 4th so we can continue to fund club projects in the future!!



- Because of his numerous contributions and years of service, Corey announced that the Nominating Committee and Board of Directors have nominated Bill "Max" Factor as an Honorary Member of the Zanesville Rotary Daybreak Club. A motion was brought to the floor, was seconded and unanimously passed. Max will be recognized at next week's awards meeting

- Rusty Montgomery gave a quick (for him) update on the Miracle League and mentioned that a work party will be needed in the near future to do some clean up and beautification of the facility. Date TBA. He and Ruthie Ware also asked for some volunteers to help during the games as they are challenged to get the equipment cleaned and disinfected

PROGRAM

Our guest speaker was Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Zanesville Executive Director Katie Mainini. Katie was introduced by Francine Swiger. Katie also brought a helper, Ava Peterbaugh, one of the program "littles". Ava is going into the 8th grade at Zanesville Middle School.



Ava did an excellent job out talking about what she and her "big" Sammy do and how much the program has helped her.

She, (Ava) had some anger issues when she was younger and having someone like Sammy to talk to has helped her with that. She talked about some of the activities that they do, and that going to movies and getting ice cream, especially Tom's, was her favorite!



Katie was excited with the results of Bowl for Kids' Sake. Despite the challenges presented, 75 teams participated and they were able to raise over \$71,000 for their programs.

Additionally, they recently added Noble County to their service area and are really excited to be bringing the Lunch Buddies program to Caldwell Elementary. They will be recruiting mentors and Bigs from Caldwell High School to assist with that program. Speaking of Lunch Buddies, they are going to be bringing that back for the 2021-2022 school year. They have the the program set to go at John McIntire Elementary, Zane Grey Elementary, and West Muskingum Elementary. Katie talked about a grant that they recently received from the Straker Foundation that will fund a partnership with the local YMCA. The program will allow registered "littles" to participate in YMCA programs, at no cost. They are really looking forward to putting that program into motion and seeing the outcomes.

Katie mentioned that Big Brothers Big Sisters, in cooperation with the Zanesville Jaycees and Secrest Auditorium will be hosting the Battle

of the Bands on August 7th. The event will be at Secrest and start at 4:00. Winning bank will receive 4 hours of recording time at Weird Music Studios and a photo shoot.

Katie then opened it up to the floor for questions and Corey presented her and Ava with our speaker gift, a cell phone sanitizing kit.
