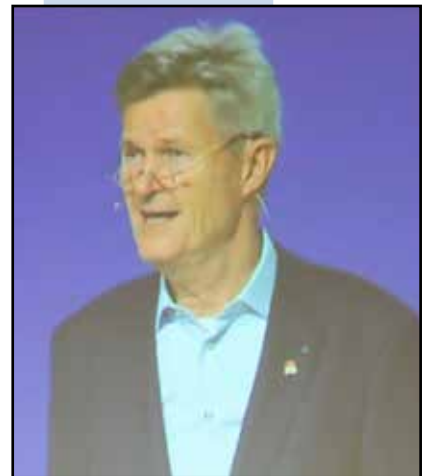

President Elect Knaack revealed the 2020-21 presidential theme "Rotary Opens Opportunities" to assembly attendees, emphasizing that Rotary isn't just a club for people to join, but rather an invitation to endless opportunities - creating pathways for members to improve their lives and the lives of those they help through service projects. He stated, "Everything we do opens another opportunity for someone, somewhere."



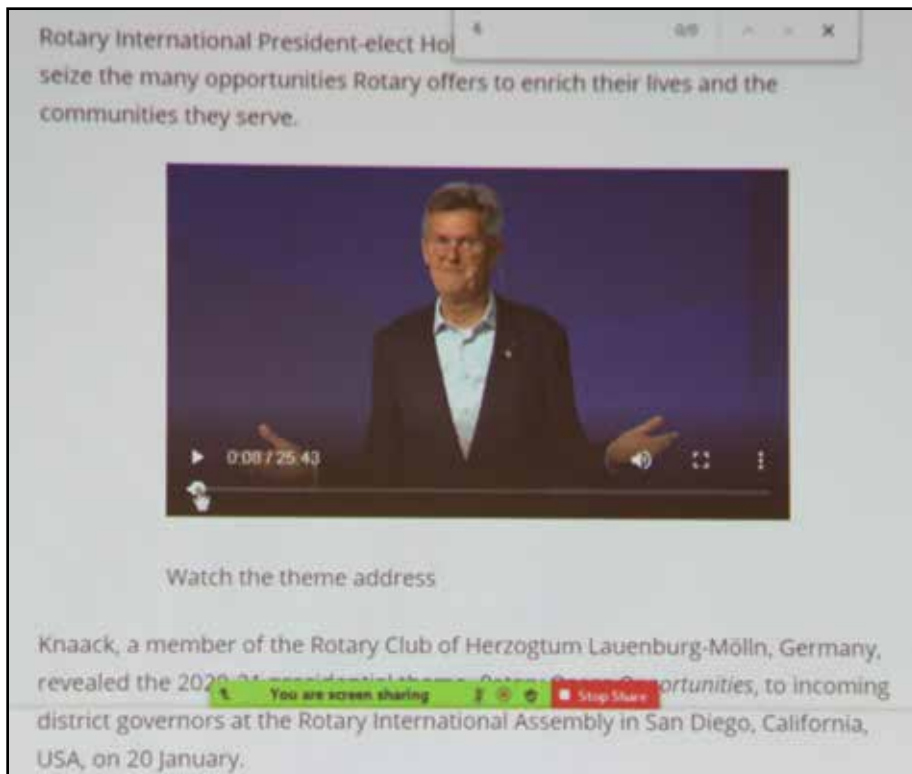
He urged members to embrace change so Rotary can expand and thrive. Rather than setting a specific target for increasing the number of members, he is asking clubs to find ways to grow in a sustainable and organic way - focusing on keeping current members engaged while adding new members who are the right fit for their club.

Knaack stated: "Every new member changes us a little bit. That person brings a new perspective, new experiences. We need to embrace this constant renewal. We will grow stronger as we learn from new members."

He pointed to Rotary's Action Plan as a compass that can guide clubs as they evolve. He recommended that each club:

- Have a strategic plan meeting at least once a year, asking where they want to be in five years and how they can bring more value to their members;
- Engage more women in leadership roles;
- Ensure that Rotaractors play an integral role in forming and running new clubs;
- Encourage district leaders to create new club models and rethink what it means to be in Rotary, and allow young people to be the architects of these new clubs.

President Elect Knaack stressed the need for Rotary members to embrace change, noting that time will not slow down for Rotary, ending with this thought: "We will capture this moment to grow Rotary, making it stronger, more adaptable, and even more aligned with our core values."
