Some 13 Rotarians and 2 Rotaractors (forming five teams) got up bright and early to personally visit and deliver "goody bags" to some 245 first responders as they changed shifts at Genesis Community Ambulance Service, Muskingum County Sheriff's Department, South Zanesville Police and Fire Departments, ValueCare Ambulance Service and Zanesville Police Department.

The lead volunteer at each station addressed the first responders with this message:
