TEACHER WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

At Daybreak's August 6th meeting, Keely Warden suggested that the club host a pop-up event to show support for teachers as the school year starts amid so many uncertainties. Members started sharing ideas immediately, with the goal of using our 4:30 p.m. meeting on August 20th to complete the message to be delivered to schools opening the week of August 24th.

A working committee of some 13 members, headed by Keely, was formed to develop a solid plan for the club's "Teacher Welcome Back to School" service project. After determining that there are 33 schools in Muskingum County, it was decided that making a banner for each one would be difficult, very time-consuming, and expensive. Instead, it was decided to have 8"x11" table tents printed with the image of Dr. Seuss along with our logo and message on the back, "BECAUSE WE CARE!" There will be plenty of room for club members to write personal notes of support on the inside and back of the table tents. Each school will receive a bag filled with candy to put in the teachers' break room. This bag will include a signed table tent, along with (non-religious) affirmation cards to be used as decided by the teachers.



Starting around 3:00 p.m. volunteers gathered at the Miracle League Park to organize a method to allow club members to come and sign the table tents. Thanks to the Starlight crew, tables and chairs were arranged to help in the process. Hand sanitizer and masks were

available to all involved. The gift bags were filled and ready to go once members completed signing all those table tents.

All was ready for the 4:30 p.m. meeting. Daybreak Rotarians arrived, received instructions on the process, picked up a Sharpie and began



writing their personal notes of encouragement on each of the 33 table tents (with much bantering going on, of course).

As members checked with schools to find the best way to deliver the bags, it became clear that each district had its own method



for accepting the gifts. Most schools will quarantine the bags for their required amount of time and then deliver them to the teachers' lounges. Each delivery volunteer will check with his/her assigned district to make sure the delivery meets with its guidelines.



After all table tents were signed and the bags were boxed for delivery, the dinner bell was sounded and club members headed to the concession stand for hot dogs, coney sauce, chips, and bottled water, served by none other than Bill Porter and Caribeth Legats.

True to tradition, Daybreak Rotarians combined work and fun to show support to teachers at the start of this unusual school year.
