### PROGRAM:

John Pattison introduced the speaker this morning, Monica Moore. Monica, who experienced a rough childhood, has a background that enables her to understand where many people are coming from in their battle with literacy and is able to relate to their needs.

The Muskingum County Literacy Council strives to reduce functional literacy and promote literacy solutions for youth and adults. 10 to 15% of Muskingum County's citizens are not literate by the standard of a third grade reading level.

The MCLC holds many events in our community to promote their vision. The Salvation Army is one place where readers go to help local people learn better reading skills and





also several after school programs from county schools. Here, they learn the joy of reading and are taught good reading habits. BARD, the bunny, helps excite locals, young and old, about reading. Other places that the MCLC goes to reach out to learners are: The Carr Center, Boys Scouts, YMCA and several outreach programs. A summer vacation journal was included with all last year's programs that included writing prompts.

A big sponsorship comes from the J.W. & M.H. Straker Foundation and participation in Dolly Parton's Imagination Library. Ohio receives a boost from First Lady, Fran DeWine and provided 41,125 books to Muskingum County and to 2800 registered children. 750 have graduated at this point!!!



The books that we put labels in this morning go to all second graders in Muskingum County and include a read-along with an adult. All books strengthen social-emotional awareness and include giving the book to each student.

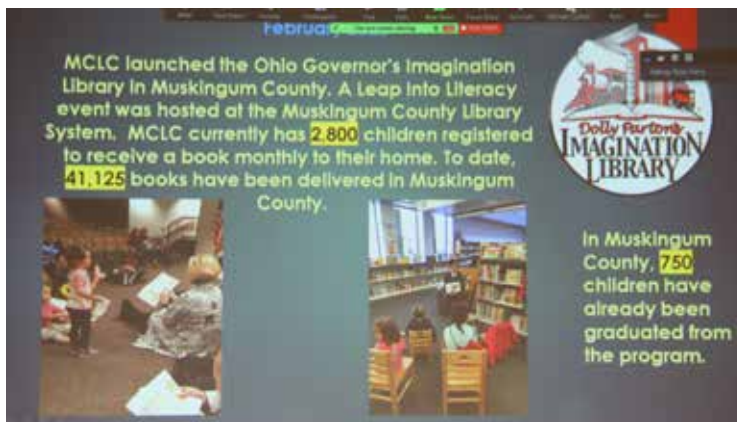
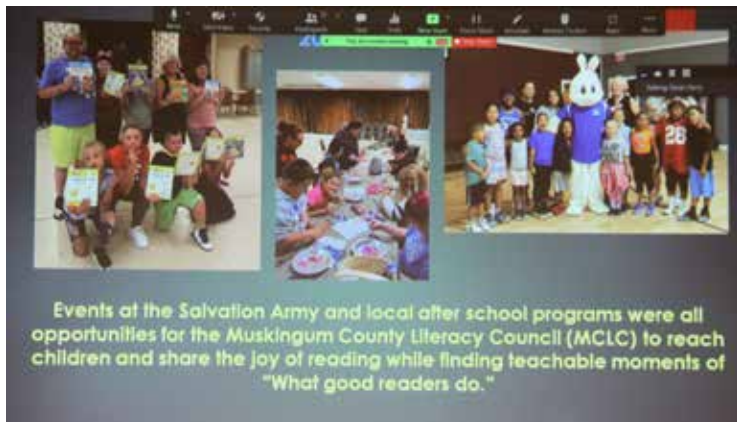
