Speaking of DACdb, please be sure to go in and verify your roster information as Tom Heins is working on the club roster/book.

Past President Ed asked for some help this coming Tuesday from 9a-12p. He and his scouts have been putting together ballot covers for the upcoming election. The Election board has asked for 30,000 covers to be done. To date they have about 21,000 completed. Anyone that can help, please let Ed know.

Keely reminded us that this coming Sunday is their reverse "Soup"er Bowl. This year, rather than coming to Secrest to eat some soup, they are asking people to come by and drop off soup. She also brought us up to date on the Farmers to Families program. The program, funded through the CARES Act, packs nutritious food boxes - \$45 value- to be distributed in our community. Last week they delivered 700 boxes to area seniors. This week they will be delivering 674 boxes to residents in the Metro Housing area as well as the Commodities Seniors will get an additional box this week as well. Next week they are anticipating 1,080 boxes to be distributed in our area. If you can help, the distribution will be from 10-2 on Wednesday the 21st. After that distribution, our community will have been the benefactor of over \$100,000 of fresh food. Awesome!

Jamie reported that some of the coats that Rotary donated to Eastside last year went unused, so she is talking them down to the Salvation Army for their annual coat drive/distribution.

HAPPY BUCKET –

We were happy to welcome Bruce Barclay back to the meeting this morning. Despite technical difficulties that didn't allow us to see him, he was able to kick off the Happy Bucket and ended up raising \$165 for Polio Plus. He also said that next week is the "Big Week" as it is World Polio Day.

Brian Wagner introduced today's guest, Kathy Braidich with "**The Turban Project**".



Kathy introduced herself and then shared a video (link below) about her powerful and inspiring ministry. Kathy leads a nonprofit group that sews Turbans, Beanies, Face Masks and Courage Caps for Cancer patients. It started with one turban for one patient and has grown to over 124,000 items. They supply items to over 50 hospitals, usually in the infusion center, across the United States. The Turbans are free and they encourage the recipients to take more than one so that they can match them to various outfits.
