October 25 Guest Speaker -- New SSU Women's Basketball Coach DeWayne Burroughs



DeWayne Burroughs is only the third coach in what will be the SSU women's basketball program's 34th season of competition. A graduate of Coppin State University in Maryland, Burroughs brings 25 years of coaching experience to the Bears.

Burroughs previously coached at three different high schools in the Baltimore, MD area: amassing an overall record of 143-40 at Woodlawn High School, St. Paul School for Girls, and Northwestern High School. At Woodlawn, Burroughs won four Baltimore County Championships and three regional championships, with an appearance in the state semifinals and two appearances in the state championship.

His college coaching career started as an assistant at NCAA Division II Bowie State (in Maryland), during which time Bulldogs compiled a 95-45 overall record in his five seasons on staff. That mark included no fewer than 18 wins in any season during the five-year stretch, including a 22-5 overall record during the 2007-08 season.

Following a strong five-year tenure at Bowie State, Burroughs moved on to coach as an assistant for the University of District Columbia, a fellow NCAA Division II member that was coached by Lester Butler. UDC went 77-38 overall record in four seasons under Butler.

He later took over as head coach at UDC, posting a 21-9 overall record before leaving to take the job at NCAA Division I Coppin State -- a position that Burroughs held from 2016 to 2020.

Burroughs boasts national recruiting connections, as his 2021-2022 roster includes players from Baltimore, Maryland, Brooklyn, New York, West Palm Beach, Florida, Sacramento, California and Las Vegas, Nevada.

He is married to Tabby Rideout Burroughs and they are the parents of three children -- Kristina, Christopher and Stephanie.
