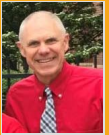

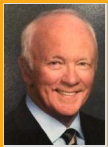

3. Describe the Project - What will be done, when, where? Is there a partner involved? Have you evaluated and verified the need for this project?
4. How many people will benefit?
5. How many Rotarians will be involved - who will be on your committee (if required)
6. What is the anticipated budget for the project? Provide brief details.

Simple, right? We will need this information submitted by club meeting on **JULY 22, 2021**

The Foundation Board will then review all submissions and let the Rotarian Sponsor know of the status by mid-August.

Remember - this is for the \$5000 DISTRICT GRANT.

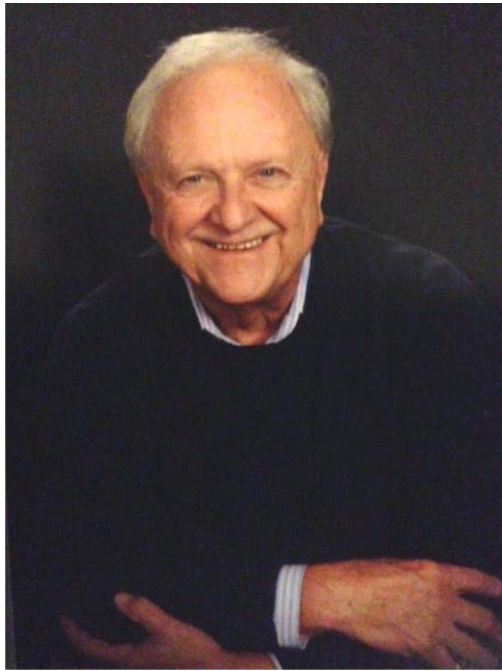
