About our Guest Speaker:

Ryan Quarles was elected Kentucky's Commissioner of Agriculture in 2015. Under his leadership, the Kentucky Department of Agriculture (KDA) has started several new programs, including initiatives to combat hunger and connect Kentucky's farmers to new markets. Ryan Quarles has also supported the expansion of Kentucky's diverse agricultural portfolio to include industrial hemp, kenaf, and hops. This has led to the historic rise of Kentucky's Industrial Hemp Program.

As a result of his Kentucky Hunger Initiative, Kentucky now has the strongest food donation immunity law in the country, and more Kentuckians are talking about the chronic problem of food insecurity than ever before. Ryan Quarles' leadership on internation trade issues saw the resumption of live equine exports to China, a decision that benefits all sectors of Kentucky's agricultural economy for horse breeders to feed producers. Under his direction, the KDA continues to look for more opportunities for Kentucky farmers to grow domestic and international markets.
