"My Old Kentucky Home Reimagined With GEDDI's America Reimagined Campaign: 7 Opportunities To Take Immediate Action Against Racial and Economic Justice as a Collective."

At the July 16th Rotary Club of Louisville Zoom meeting, entrepreneur and founder of the Derby Diversity Business Summit (DDBS), Tawana Bain detailed the founding of the Global Economic Diversity Development Initiative (GEDDI), a 501 (c) 3 non-profit foundation created to further the diversity, equity, and inclusion work with a specific enphasis on addressing the systemic issues within the Black Community. GEDDI (pronounced JED-eye), is a 100% Black founded and Black lead foundation based in Louisville, Kentucky. GEDDI's sole purpose over the next 5 years is supplying economic empowerment, supply chain development, leadership and workforce development with a specific focus on creating equity and opportunity for the Black Community utilizing a proprietary system.
