About our Speaker and his presentation:

"Race & Justice Matters: A Civil Dialogue" A series of tragic deaths of African-Americans including the recent shooting of Breonna Taylor, in her Louisville home, have ignited a city and nation seeking racial and social justice.

This week we will begin the first of a series of programs that examine the path forward. How do we address discrimination and what are the root causes? What do we need to do so that every child in our city has the opportunity for a bright future?

Our guest speaker is Metro Council President David James. A retired police office having served a distinguished career, he was also a part of the United States Army Reserves as a Military Intelligence Specialist. Additionally, James was Commissioner of the Kentucky Bureau of Investigation from 2004-2007. In November 2010, David James was elected as councilman of the Metro Council's Sixth District. And, in 2020, he was elected to serve a third term as President of the Metro Council.

Active in the community, David James has served on many charitable organizations including Kosair Charities Advisory Board, University of Louisville Board of Trustees, Board of Governors for Speed Art Museum, Restorative Justice Louisville Board of Directors. The Fraternal Order of Police Board of Directors and more.

Joining Metro President James on the program will be a representative of Black Lives Matter, a movement fighting for

freedom, liberation and justice.
