

About Senator Mitch McConnell:

Mitch McConnell is the U.S. Senate Majority Leader. Elected to that position unanimously by his Republican colleagues first in 2014 and again in 2016 and 2018, he is only the second Kentuckian to ever serve as Majority Leader in the U.S. Senate. McConnell was first unanimously elected by his colleagues as the Republican Leader in 2006. He is the longest-serving Senate Republican Leader in the history of the United States.

The title of Senator McConnell's presentation is "A Conversation with Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell."

About Dr. Michael Clark:

Michael W. Clark is the Director of the Center for Business and Economic Research and an Associate Professor of Economics at the University of Kentucky's Gatton College of Business and Economics. He earned a B.A. in Management and an M.S. and Ph.D. in economics from the University of Kentucky.

In his presentation titled "The COVID-19 Recession: How the Pandemic has Affected Kentucky's Economy," Dr. Clark will provide an economic overview of how the global pandemic has impacted the regional economy and will forecast how policy changes may impact the recovery. He will also offer insight to businesses on what to expect in the months ahead.
