"The Biggest Community Improvement You May Never See"



About the presentation:

Louisville residents likely will never see one of the community's largest public infrastructure projects, but we'll all experience its benefits for generations. More than 18 stories underground and stretching for four miles underneath parts of Louisville, the Waterway Protection Tunnel is MSD's innovative approach to reducing the damaging and potentially dangerous sewer overflows that can occur during heavy rains. MSD Executive Director Tony Parrott will visit with the Rotary Club of Louisville to provide an update on this important project as it reaches a key milestone in its multi-year construction.

More About Tony Parrott:

James A. "Tony" Parrott serves as the Executive Director of Louisville MSD, providing executive leadership, strategic direction, and management, ensuring implementation of MSD's core values and mission of---Safe, clean waterways. Tony also provides leadership for MSD's One Water Partnership with Louisville Water Company. Tony provides strategic leadership to MSD's 650 employees who perform and support day-to-day operations, with an annual operating budget of \$350M. Tony also interacts with local, state and federal elected officials and regulatory agencies and must prioritize available funds to fit ever-changing wastewater, stormwater, and flood protection regulations. Tony presents MSD initiatives and programs to local and national professional and regulatory groups and local civic, neighborhood groups, and the media.

Louisville MSD provides wastewater collection and treatment, flood protection, and stormwater services to more than 850,000 Jefferson County residents, and recently the agency added 6,000 Oldham County customers for wastewater services. Louisville Metro Mayor appoints MSD's Executive Director, who reports to the MSD Board of Directors.

The October 1st Rotary Club of Louisville meeting featured "A Conversation with Amy McGrath," a retired Marine Corps lieutenant colonel who is running for U.S. Senate in Kentucky. Amy grew up in Northern Kentucky and graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy. She became the first woman in the Marine Corps to fly a combat mission in an F/A-18 fighter jet. During her 20 years as a Marine, she served three combat tours overseas and as a congressional fellow advising a senior member of the House Armed Services Committee on defense and foreign policy. She went on to serve in the Pentagon as Marine Corps' liaison to the State Department.


