Dr. Janice Crews is an oboist, music educator, and arts administrator from Athens, Georgia. She began her career as a public school music teacher before pursuing graduate studies in music performance and eventually landing in arts administration.



Currently, Crews is the Director of the Center of Excellence for the Creative Arts and the Community School of the Arts at Austin Peay State University, where she enjoys sharing the power of the arts with her community.
