### WAR HERO / PRISONER OF WAR

This week our guest will be Retired Lieutenant Colonel O-5 Glenn Myers of the US Air Force. He was commissioned a 2<sup>nd</sup> Lt in 1965 and was taken as a Prisoner Of War during the Vietnam War. Capt. Myers spent 2,045 days in captivity and was released during Operation Homecoming on March 14, 1973. He retired from the Air Force on November 1, 1985. He is a recipient of the Silver Star Medal for his devotion to duty during his time in captivity.
