The ministry is a non-profit, non-denominational, service-based organization consisting of various churches in our community including Baptist, Methodist, Church of God, Catholic and independent all involved with helping underserved families. Its goal is for children to be able to go back to school with confidence and the supplies they need to be successful at school and ultimately successful in life. Give A Kid A Chance provides a backpack filled with school supplies, new shoes, a bible, lunch, vision screening, hearing screening, and a haircut to needy children entering grades K – 12. Due to Covid-19 considerations, the screening programs will not be provided this year, but approximately 540 children will receive backpacks in 2020. Funding and other support comes from local churches, civic organizations, businesses, and individuals.

At Monday night's Board of Director's meeting July 13th , the Board voted on the following: A member may request a credit on their dues of \$25/month, up to 2 months totaling \$50, for reimbursement of meals for the two months the club did not hold meetings due to COVID-19.
