Jerrod Menz, owner of Head Down Firearms, and assisted by Plant Manager Jeff Jackson discussed the company's product line and operations in Lawrenceburg. Head Down Firearms currently employs ten people and manufactures 25 to 50 firearms per day. The company is primarily an assembly operation that manufactures its own AR lower receiver while outsourcing the barrel and other accessories. Menz and Jackson discussed record keeping requirements for serialized components, namely the lower, and other considerations for firearm manufacture. When looking for a location to set up his business, Menz chose Lawrenceburg because of a firearm friendly and business friendly environment plus encouragement from wife Melinda who grew up in Lawrence County.
