Program— Kid's Place Child Advocacy with Brandi Burdette

Brandi Burdette, Executive Director of Kid's Place Child Advocacy Center detailed the services of the Kid's Place Child Advocacy Center that provides legal support for children who have been victims of sexual or severe physical abuse. Their facility is located in the old Childrens' Home on West Point Road near Lawrenceburg and they are now equipping a recently donated home in Wayne County. The group works with Law Enforcement and the District Attorney's Office to assist in developing evidence where children have been abused, and to provide counseling and other services for the victims and their families. Kid's Place CAC is currently serving 330 clients from Lawrence and surrounding counties. Funding comes primarily from grants with private donations and fundraising efforts making up a significant portion of their budget. One such fundraiser is the Kid's Place Demolition Derby which was held on Saturday (July 31) at Lawrenceburg Rotary Park.
