Program— Robert d'Ablaing of **Buffalo River Hemp Company**



Pictured above President Greg Kelso, Richard d'Ablaing, operator of his family owned Buffalo River Hemp Company. Richard started his business approximately four years ago when his son suffered from after effects of an accident induced brain injury. Hemp is not FDA approved for diagnosis or treatment of any medical conditions, however there is anecdotal evidence of its effectiveness when combined with certain herbs. Hemp is a close cousin to Marijuana, however Mr. d'Ablaing emphasized that the crops he grows have a very small proportion high producing THC versus pain relieving CBD. Growing, harvesting, and processing hemp into CBD oil and related products is very labor intensive and there is a significant capital outlay required to produce on a scale large enough for an Industrial Hemp business to be profitable.
