This and his deep Christian faith motivated him to create Advocates for Africa with his wife Katina. The organization works with individuals who are already making a difference in their communities in order to deepen their impact as opposed to duplicating it. One of their projects is building the Advocates Christian Academy that will provide food, clean water, and educational opportunities for poor children in Rwanda.
