Greg Kelso, Speaker Bob Huffman, Rotary Foundation Chair Bill Phillips. The Rotary Past District Governor Bob Huffman gave an interesting presentation on Rotary's charitable arm, The Rotary Foundation. The mission of The Rotary Foundation is to enable Rotarians to advance world understanding, goodwill, and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education, and the alleviation of poverty. The foundation is leading an international effort to eliminate Polio from the face of the earth and has reduced the incidence of wild polio from over 350,000 cases per year to only 2 cases so far in 2021. The foundation also funds local and international projects in seven areas of focus, including clean water - sanitation and hygiene, fighting disease, supporting education, saving mothers and children, promoting peace, growing local economies, and protecting the environment. Lawrenceburg Rotarians and the local club have actively supported The Rotary Foundation for over 40 years.
