VIRTUAL ROTARY-MARCH 8, 2021: PRESERVING TENNESSEE'S HISTORY FOR POSTERITY: A PREVIEW OF THE NEW STATE LIBRARY AND ARCHIVES BUILDING

Tennessee Secretary of State Tre Hargett previews the new Tennessee State Library and Archives building, scheduled to open to the public in April. The 165,000 square foot state-of-the-art facility, located at the Bicentennial Capitol Mall, features a robotic automated storage and retrieval system, an audio heritage lab, and a literacy center for hearing-impaired children. Additionally, there are displays for the Tennessee state constitution, classrooms for public engagement events, a large outdoor courtyard, accommodations for genealogical and scholarly researchers and a rare book collection.

About our speaker:

Tre Hargett was elected by the Tennessee General Assembly to serve as Tennessee's 37th secretary of state in 2009 and reelected in 2013 and 2017. Secretary Hargett is the chief executive officer of the Department of State with oversight of more than 300 employees. He also serves on 16 boards and commissions, on two of which he is the presiding member. The services and oversight found in the Secretary of State's office reach every department and agency in state government.
